- Made & sold over 12 fleece blankets for fundraising purposes.

- Club members researched ways to cut down on fuel costs.
- New Siding and insulation projected started ,
- Donated money for breakfast food to Edwardsburg High School Project Graduation.
- Held three Hunter Safety Classes.
- \$250.00 Copper Sponsor of the American Cancer Society's Relay for Life event held in Edwardsburg.
- Meeting place for two Michiana Bicycle Association bike rides.
- June 6th host of Relay For Life Breakfast fundraiser, Special Olympics Motorcycle Rally fundraiser and a stop on the Takin' It To The Streets food pantry fundraiser which collected over 1 ton of food.

SHOOTING RANGE RULES REVISED

MEMBERS MUST BE PREPARED TO SHOW THEIR MEMBERSHIP CARD IF ASKED.

ALL MEMBERS ARE EXPECTED TO FOLLOW AND ENFORCE RANGE RULES.

ONLY MEMBERS & GUESTS ARE ALLOWED TO SHOOT ON THE RANGES.

MINORS MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES.

MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR GUEST(S). NO MORE THAN THREE AT A TIME. (UPON A GUEST'S 3RD VISIT TO THE RANGE THEY SHOULD APPLY FOR CLUB MEMBERSHIP).

NO 50 BMG TO BE FIRED AT THE RANGE.

NO BELT Fed OR FULLY AUTOMATIC FIREARMS ALLOWED.

NO UNCONTROLLABLE RAPID FIRE.

NO UNCASSED FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION ON BACK COUNTER. NO LOADING FROM BACK COUNTER.

ALWAYS KEEP YOUR MUZZLE POINTED DOWNRANGE IN A SAFE DIRECTION.

YOU ARE YOUR OWN RANGE OFFICER-SPEAK LOUDLY AND CLEARLY WHEN NEEDING TO GO DOWN RANGE.

HANDLING ANY FIREARM WHILE SOMEONE IS DOWNRANGE IS PROHIBITED.

SHOOTING AT TARGETS ON SHOOTING TABLE & BENCHES IS PROHIBITED.

MAKE SURE ALL SHOTS ARE BEING STOPPED BY BERMS.

SHOOT ONLY OBJECTS THAT WILL NOT CAUSE RICOCHET-AVOID STEEL TARGETS, BOWLING PINS, ROCKS, ETC-ABSOLUTELY NO GLASS.

HANGING TARGETS IN TREES & ON BUSHES OR SHOOTING IN THE WOODS IS PROHIBITED.

REMOVE TARGETS (BROKEN OR WHOLE) WHEN DONE SHOOTING, TAKE THEM HOME OR PLACE IN TRASH BARRELS.

DO NOT PLACE LIVE AMMUNITION IN TRASH BARRELS.

REFRAIN FROM CLIMBING ON BERMS& DO NOT DIG IN THEM.

BE COURTEOUS TO OTHERS ON RANGE.

THE USE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS WHILE SHOOTING IS PROHIBITED.

EYE & EAR PROTECTION STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.

ANY UNSAFE BEHAVIOR COULD RESULT IN EXPULSION OR LOSS OF SHOOTING PRIVILEGES.

ALWAYS LOCK THE GATE AFTER ENTERING PROPERTY & WHEN LEAVING (UNLESS AN ORGANIZED EVENT IS IN PROGRESS. MEMBERS WILL BE ABLE TO LET THEMSELVES OUT.

DO NOT GIVE THE GATE COMBINATION TO ANYONE.

We started our youth trap shooting program in the Spring of 2009. Through an NRA grant and generous donations from club members and guests we were able to provide ammunition and approximately 30,000 clay targets to our new shooters at no cost to them. We also took 12 of our young guns to Mason, Mi for their first ATA shoot and covered all fees and transportation costs. We want to continue and expand our program and offer shooting education and opportunities to our youth free of charge for as long as we possibly can do it. This takes funds and dedicated volunteers and we are very thankful for what we have received so far. The Edwardsburg Conservation Club will hold a "Draw Down Raffle" on Saturday February 13, 2010 to help raise more funds to support our program. Throughout the evening there will be ten \$50.00 winning tickets drawn.
