SUMMER YOUTH CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS

It was approved at the May Board meeting to help fund camping fees for up to six campers to attend a one week camp experience at the Van Buren Youth Camp this summer. Parents will be responsible to pay the \$125.00 deposit and the ECC will pick up the remaining \$125.00. Van Buren Youth Camp is located in Bloomingdale, Michigan on 90 acres of woodland bordering Great Bear Lake in Van Buren County about half way between Kalamazoo and South Haven.

Early Youth Camp for children ages 8-11 includes programs in swimming, canoeing, archery, riflery,

drama, folk dancing, sports, team building, nature and arts & crafts. Camp Dates are June 22-28, July 20-26 .

Middle Youth , ages 12-14 offers the same programs as early youth, with more focus on developing leadership skills. Camp Dates are July 13-19 and July 27

to August 2.
